# **Double 'Treble' Winners!**

Shotts YMCA Reds 98s recently completed the treble for the second year in a row – a 'Double Treble' !!! The boys remarkably won their last 18 games on the trot to win the West Lothian Under 16 Youth League, by 4 points from their rivals Milton BC, who they also beat in the County Cup Final, winning 2-0. The boys also won the League Cup, where they defeated Broxburn Athletic 2-0. This really is a fantastic achievement for the team as they became the first team in the history of West Lothian Youth football to achieve back to back trebles. In addition to the treble Shotts also won the 'Land 'O' Burns pre season tournament [ so 4 trophies in all]!

The County Cup defence started way back last October when Shotts trounced Linlithgow 10-2. After fighting through several tricky rounds, the team against reached the final at Livingston FC's stadium against Milton BC, their main and fiercest of rivals. The boys' class and experience shone through in an emphatic 2-0 victory. The treble was possible once more!

In the League cup, the boys once again put together a fine run to reach yet another final, this time against Broxburn Athletic who had drawn the previous league game with Shotts 3-3. A very competitive game ensued, with a few feisty challenges dished out along the way, but as usual the team that came up with the goods was Shotts. The boys stuck to their game plan, won their individual battles all over the park and came out on top, winning comfortably in the end 2-0. The treble was now a reality! The league season had started with rivals Milton BC winning their first 12 league games in succession, but as Milton crumbled under the pressure of the chasing the champions, the league came down to the final game, between the two contenders. The Shotts boys produced a fantastic performance and crushed their opponents 4-0 with a fantastic display of attacking football in front of the biggest crowd of the season. The Treble was secured again!

Over the season Shotts scored 249 goals in 47 matches (over 5 goals per game average). No fewer than 3 players scored more than 40 goals each, but the each member of the squad played a massive part in this historic achievement. The midfielders contributed with over 100 goals between them but key to the team's success were the 25 clean sheets, as the defence and goalkeeper proved they are the best in the region.

What now? A 'Treble Treble'? – The boys seem to think it's achievable, so we will give it a go and try and set the bar so high that it could be a long time before any team emulates what Shotts YMCA Reds 98s have done. The situation in Sierra Leone is a desperate one. Hundreds of thousands of people in Freetown, Sierra Leone live in unimaginable squalor. An EU report declared that over 280,000 homes were needed in Freetown, Sierra Leone; none have been built. People often live ten-to-a-hovel, with no

power or water. Disease in these makeshift shacks is rampant and death comes early.

Mission Direct's founder and former chief executive, Nigel Hyde has established the Home Leone initiative. The aim: to build 1,000 homes, each costing less than £5,000.

Dave visited Sierra Leone earlier this year and found the inspiration for the 'Maninashack' Endurance Challenge. "I am running for Home Leone and hope to raise enough money to build 40 homes in Sierra Leone. Please support me and make a significant impact on the lives of those earning less than £1 a day living in one of the poorest nations on earth."
