12 Months On...

It's now 12 months since the launch of Workshop Routing at the National Space Centre in June. Written in Microsoft PowerApps, Workshop Routing can be used on Windows, Android and Apple IOS devices.

If you recall, the main purpose of Workshop Routing is to automate the movement of jobs from their receipt in to their completion out.

As the item arrives in the workshop, it captures information on the equipment as the engineer enters the nameplate details and takes photographs of each aspect of the item before automatically raising a job in EMIR and attaching relevant pictures.


Workshop Routing then records the movement of the repair and displays in Visual Management at what stage the item resides, receipt, inspection, quotation, repair or despatch. This live information is shown on a dashboard which can be projected to a wall mounted

monitor, a desktop PC, the tablet device in the workshop or smart phone of the engineer or manager.

Version 7 is on Release...

In the latest version the interface has been completely redesigned to make the entry of data even simpler.

The entry fields are larger and compulsory fields have been identified with a bold red line. As an engineer you can add as much or as little detail as is needed with the option to supplement entry in EMIR at a later point.




Paperless Architecture...
