New Financial Standard has implications for EMIR Stock Valuation. Act Now!

You may or may not be aware that there is a new Financial Reporting Standard, FRS102, starting for financial periods commencing on the 01/01/2015 and there is one change that will affect EMIR users directly...

Stock valuation should no longer be based on a "Unit Cost" (as in the previous SSAP9 standard) and can only be based as described in section 13.18 of FRS102, namely:

13.18 An entity shall measure the cost of inventories, other than those dealt with in paragraph 13.17, by using the first-in, first-out (FIFO) or weighted average cost formula. An entity shall use the same cost formula for all inventories having a similar nature and use to the entity. For inventories with a different nature or use, different cost formulas may be justified. The last-in, first-out method (LIFO) is not permitted by this FRS.

As EMIR has legitimately used Unit Cost as its basis for stock valuation (for nearly 20 years now!) it is an area that we are updating to Weighted Average Cost to meet the new standard. There is significant development involved in this change, but we are providing this update FREE to all EMIR Maintenance Contract holders, and for a reduced fee of £195 for EMIR Support Contract holders or £395 for a revised stock module for users who have neither support or maintenance contracts.

So what do you need to do?

You need to order your upgrade by the time your accounting period starts in 2015 (even if it is free!). We will then provide the new functionality to you and run the necessary setup to create the new weighted costing mechanism and further ensure that this is done by the end of your first financial period in the new year (or as soon as possible).



The update will be available by the end of January 2015, but please act fast to ensure your update is arranged in good time to suit your needs.
